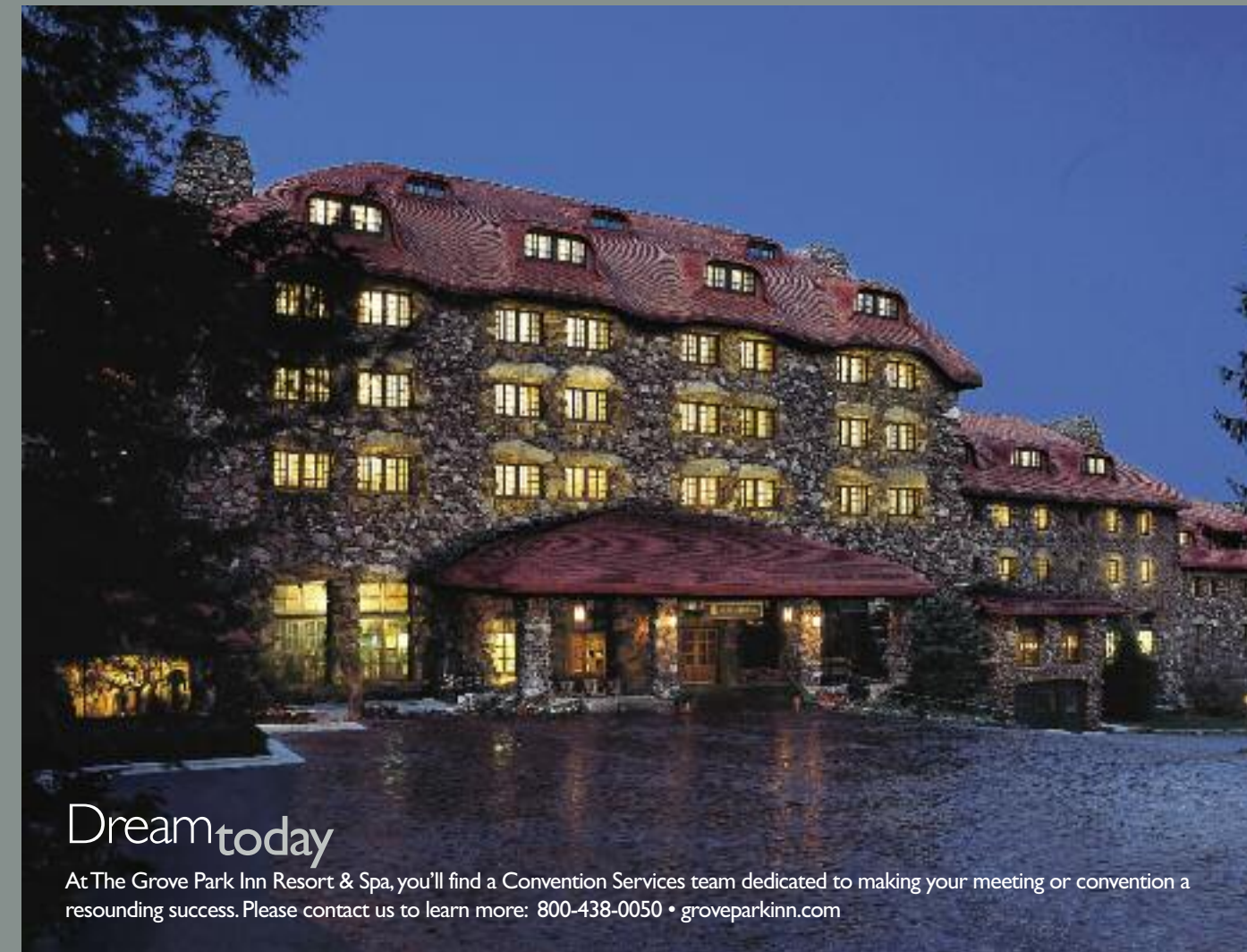


## Dream **nightlife**

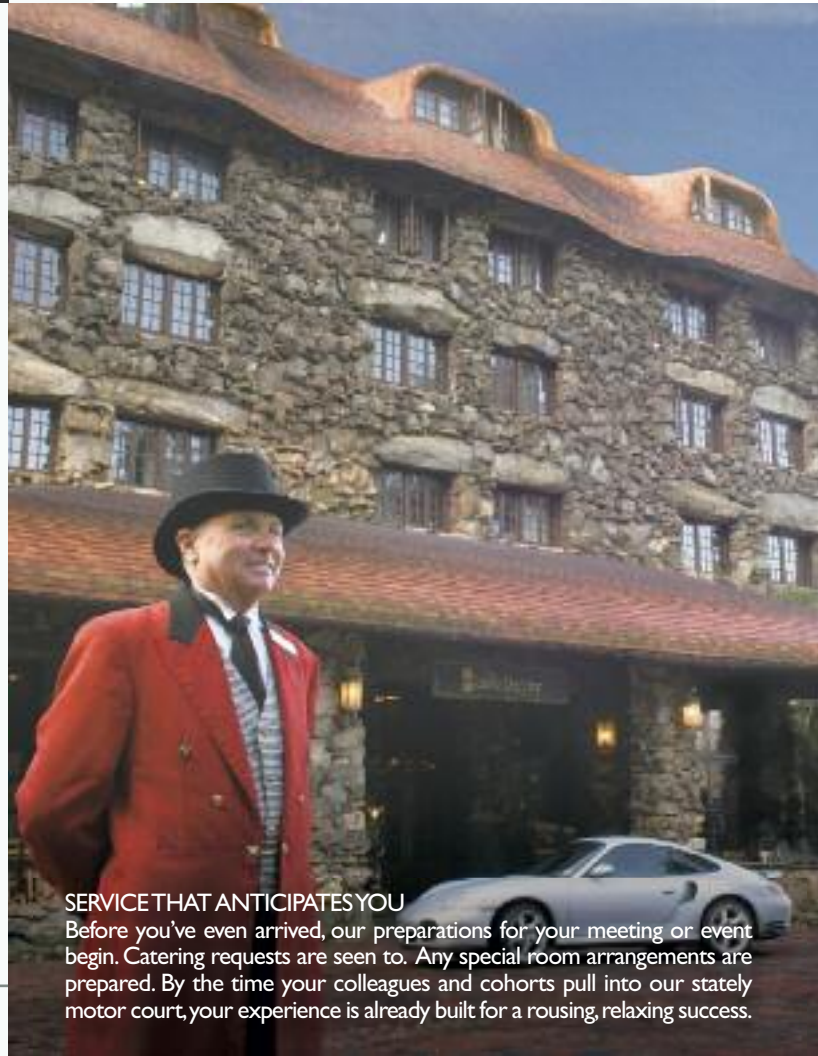

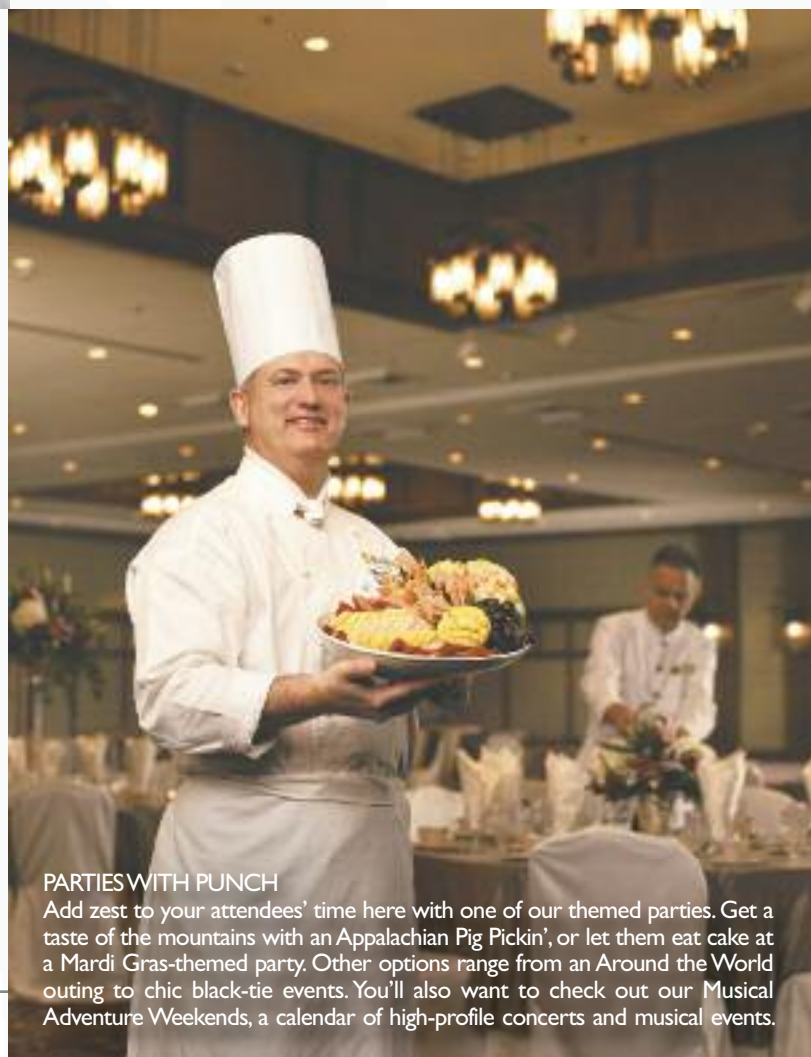

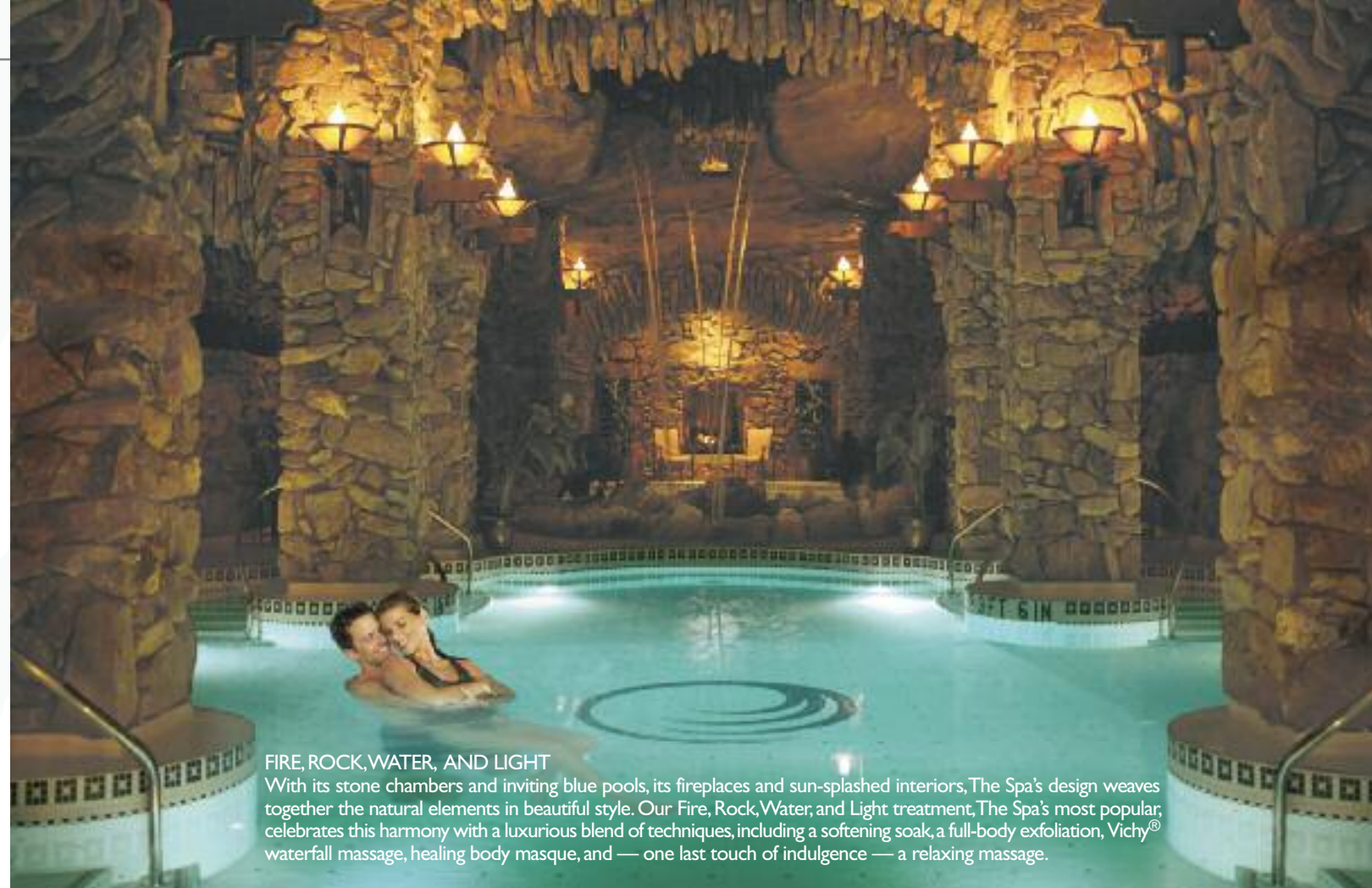

## Dreamplay

Framed by the splendor of the Blue Ridge Mountains, our 18-hole, par-70 championship golf course may be the finest expression of mountain golf around. Designed by the legendary Donald Ross, and fully restored in 2002, this is a shot-maker's course, one that emphasizes accuracy over power, making each hole a rewarding challenge for experienced and novice players alike. After your game, spend some time in our clubhouse area, which is home to an outdoor, Olympic-sized pool, as well as the Cabana Grille, an outdoor grill serving snacks and sandwiches.

For more exercise and relaxation, head to our Sports Complex. Measuring more than 50,000 square feet, this facility holds indoor and outdoor tennis courts, a racquetball court, an indoor pool, a weight-training room with Paramount® equipment, and a cardio room. A variety of fitness classes are offered daily, and the Sports Complex also hosts tennis clinics, tournaments, and other activities.
